
## Longer Chord Progressions Using Modern Chords (Level 1)


When any chord is given for 2 beats like so, ----you might try the following right hand technique:





- 1) On the first beat, play the whole chord.
- 2) On the second beat, play all the notes *except the bass* note (*do* let the bass keep ringing from the first beat though).


With the occasional addition of up-beats to some chords (ask for demonstration if necessary), this will create a nice, happy feel.


## EXAMPLE #1 MOONGLOW














Means to hold G note down, but not to play it again, just let it ring.
