


- 1) Play all 8th notes as "jazz" 8ths and "straight" 8ths.
- 2) Do all runs in the order given in the following keys: G, B, Eb, C, A (do 7th keys, not major), and make sure you transpose (using same fingering) as soon as you learn each run. This method sounds good and helps you to learn the runs more solidly.


















And recommend same rhythm on other 13th runs

Transpose and learn to see these runs as usual.


