Assignment:

Just learn everything in this one key, but learn it really well...what this means is:

- 1) Know each segment backwards and forwards, in descending order (i.e. starting high on the neck with the last segment and working your way down) as well as ascending.
- 2) Mix the notes up in each little segment in lots or orders. Think *MELODIES*. If you can't find music in 6 notes, you're relying too much on remembered hand movements. There are *tons* of worthwhile melodies in there. Remember to play in RHYTHM, different grooves and also out-of-time ala a very expressive singer.
