# Notes on Tony's Tunes

One tune actually began on IV, centered on IV (repeatedly) yet was not in IV .... for awhile until the E1 A1 G1 put the tune in the Key of A... which was the Key of A

last E1 G1 in some piece



bVI of home likes to become IV of a new key

Ex: FΔ7 in A is the bVI

but FΔ7 is also the IV of C & can lead you into the Key of C

Next: Study the 1ST INN & part DIAT.

## YOUR HARMONIC PALETTÉ

is MAINLY:

- ① DIAT. MAJ. KEY colors & much a) SU b) DIAT. CYC MOTION
- ② MODULAT. into other DIAT. MAJ. KEYS
- ③ TONICIZATION (TEMPORARY or VERY TEMPORARY MODULATION)

Ex: You ♭ a) II 11 & IV  
b) ii<sup>7</sup> I<sup>7</sup> & IV

- ④ PURE 4ths: Ex: In Key of A AΔ7 DΔ7 GΔ7  
1 smallosity CΔ7 FΔ7 BΔ7 But E1
- ⑤ Beautiful Minor

DORIAN: m7 w/ its extensions

AEOLIAN: especially the brighter spots
