

"Multi-Tonal Major Key Colors: 'Diatonic Mixtures' or 'Mixed Majors' Parallel Root Moves and Voicings"

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Example #5: "Modulation. This sustain is important here."

- **Key:** Organized sounds where one tone can be sensibly seen, and <u>heard</u>, to have generated the others.
- Tonality:The particular flavoring or color of a key...as in key of C major, or more specifically at times,
C Major Diatonic or C Blues, or C Mixolydian, or when more precision is needed, C Jazz Blues,
C Gospel Blues, Cm Chicago Blues, Cm Dorian Blues, Cm Dark Jazz Blues, and so on.
